

License Agreements

ASME's license agreement is a legally binding document protecting the rights of our institutional customers and ASME. Addendums may be used to add additional publications to an agreement, extend the license period, or incorporate policy changes when required.

ASME's license agreement includes terms requested by libraries from the academic, corporate, and government sectors. Agreements have been developed to protect the rights of our customers and to grant rights to use content in ways specific to an electronic resource and closest to traditional print usage.

The license agreement outlines the contract details, including:

- Licensed material – publications licensed by the customer
- License details – identified Institutional Administrator and targeted IP range
- Supply period – start and end dates of the site license access period
- License fee – total price for access to all licensed material for the supply period
- Terms – interpretation of the agreement, including usage rights and restrictions, terms and warranties, and customer service

The Agreement must be signed by both parties.
